



THE GREAT HALL | Venue Alcohol Policy

The Great Hall abides by the Liquor License Act of Ontario and has fully trained Smart Serve certified professional staff to ensure the safe and responsible service of alcohol at all events. With your cooperation, the staff of The Great Hall will follow these rules:

Entrances & Exits

When relevant and as determined by The Great Hall's management team, security personnel will be on duty to check ID, conduct searches of bags and patrons, deny entry to rowdy, belligerent, or intoxicated persons, prevent overcrowding or manage any patron exhibiting troublesome behavior at events where alcohol is available.

Use of Alcohol

All persons consuming alcohol in The Great Hall must be 19 years of age or older. The Great Hall's staff will not serve any patron to the point of intoxication or serve any patron already intoxicated. Staff will offer only non-alcoholic drinks to any patron who appears to be reaching the point of intoxication. A maximum of two alcoholic drinks may only be served to each patron at any one time. The Great Hall staff reserves the right to limit the amount of drinks sold to each patron at any time. No alcohol shall be brought into the venue that has not been purchased under The Great Hall's liquor license or on a Special Occasion Permit. The Great Hall has the right to confiscate and not return any illegal alcohol. No alcohol, either by glass or bottle/box, shall be permitted to leave the building except under the authority of a LCBO Special Occasion Permit.

Underage Patrons

Under-aged patrons are permitted at some events when the event is not designated as 19+. In the instance of these events, underage individuals do not have in and out privileges.

Illegal Drugs

The use of illegal drugs is prohibited by law anywhere in the venue.

Troublesome Patrons

Persons involved in troublesome behaviour, due to use of alcohol or not, will be asked to leave the premises and not return. Troublesome behaviors include: vandalism, fighting, selling or using illegal drugs, sexual harassment, physical or verbal abuse, belligerence, or other similar behaviours. The Great Hall's management reserves the right to indefinitely ban entry to these patrons as well as to contact the police should circumstances require their involvement, and also reserves the right to close bars should the situation warrant such action.

Capacity Limit & Fire Code

Fire codes and capacity ratings by the Province of Ontario and Fire Marshall will be strictly enforced by The Great Hall's security staff and management team for the protection of you, your guests, and our staff.

Bar Closing

"Last Call" for performances is determined based on the performance. The client and The Great Hall's management will jointly determine bar closing for corporate and special events. No alcohol shall be served after 2:00am.
